### FDP Practice Prevailing Rate Changes for FY 24-25

#### Region 1 – Coastal Plain: (NCFS Districts include D4, D7, D8, and D13)

- Hand Plant, Loblolly Pine rate increased from \$85 to <u>\$90 (L)</u> for a low rate, \$95 to <u>\$100 (M)</u> for a medium rate, and \$105 to <u>\$110 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 1 Districts.
- Hand Plant, Longleaf rate increased from \$100 to \$105 (L) for a low rate, and \$115 to \$120 (M) for a medium rate in all Region 1 Districts.
- Hand Plant, Shortleaf/White Pine rate increased from \$65 to <u>\$70 (L)</u> for a low rate, \$85 to <u>\$90 (M)</u> for a medium rate, and \$100 to <u>\$105 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 1 Districts.
- Hand Plant, Containerized Pine (Loblolly/Longleaf/Shortleaf) rate increased from \$140 to \$145 (L), and \$165 to \$170 (H) for a high rate in all Region 1 Districts.
- Machine Plant Pine (Loblolly/Longleaf/Shortleaf) rate increased from \$70 to <u>\$75 (L)</u> for a low rate, \$90 to <u>\$95 (M)</u> for a medium rate, and \$135 to <u>\$140 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 1 Districts.
- Machine Plant Chemical (Loblolly/Longleaf/Shortleaf) rate increased from \$100 to <u>\$105 (L)</u> for a low rate, \$140 to <u>\$145 (M)</u> for a medium rate, and \$150 to <u>\$155 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 1 Districts.

#### Region 2 - Piedmont: (NCFS Districts include D3, D5, D6, D10, and D11)

- Site Preparation Practices
  - K-G, V-Blade Shear rate increased from \$150 to <u>\$180 (L)</u> for a low rate, and \$180 to <u>\$205 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Districts.
- Tree Planting Practices
  - Hand Plant, Loblolly Pine rate increased from \$85 to <u>\$90 (L)</u> for a low rate, \$95 to <u>\$100 (M)</u> for a medium rate, and \$105 to <u>\$110 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 2 Districts.
  - Hand Plant, Longleaf/Shortleaf/White Pine rate increased from \$85 to <u>\$90 (L)</u> for a low rate, \$95 to <u>\$100 (M)</u> for a medium rate, and \$105 to <u>\$110 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 2 Districts.

- Hand Plant, Containerized Pine (Loblolly/Longleaf/Shortleaf) rate increased from \$140 to \$145 (L), and \$165 to \$170 (H) for a high rate in all Region 2 Districts.
- Machine Plant Pine (Loblolly/Longleaf/Shortleaf) rate increased from \$90 to <u>\$95 (L)</u> for a low rate, and \$130 to <u>\$135 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 2 Districts.
- Machine Plant Chemical (Loblolly/Longleaf/Shortleaf) rate increased from \$100 to <u>\$105 (L)</u> for a low rate, and \$150 to <u>\$155 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 2 Districts.
- Machine Plant Scalp (Loblolly/Longleaf/Shortleaf) rate increased from \$100 to <u>\$105 (L)</u> for a low rate, and \$140 to <u>\$145 (H)</u> for a high rate in all Region 2 Districts.

#### **<u>Region 3 - Mountains:</u>** (NCFS Districts include D1, D2, D9, and D12)
